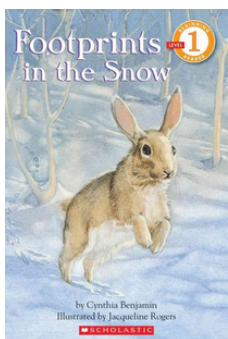

Footprints in the Snow

Winter Craft Idea



Materials Needed

- Card Stock or Watercolor Paper
- White Glue
- Table Salt
- Liquid Watercolor Paints or food coloring
- Paintbrush or Eye Dropper
- Pencil
- Snowflake Template

Instructions

1. Trace the snowflake template onto a thick piece of paper with a pencil.
2. Once traced, outline the snowflakes with white glue.
3. Pour salt over the glue
4. You can either let the glue dry completely or start painting right away. Mix some food coloring with a bit of water, or use watercolor paint, and using the paintbrush, touch it to the salt covered snowflakes.
5. Let dry
